Interpretation:

- 1. Species included in this Appendix are referred to:
- (a) by the name of the species; or
- (b) as being all of the species included in a higher taxon or designated part thereof.
- 2. The abbreviation "spp." is used to denote all the species of a higher taxon.

3. Other references to taxa higher than species are for the purposes of information or classification only.

4. An asterisk (*) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separates populations, sub-species or species of that taxon are included in Appendix I and that these populations, sub-species or species are excluded from Appendix II.

5. The symbol (#) followed by a number placed against the name of a species or higher taxon designates parts or derivatives which are specified in relation thereto for the purposes of the present Convention as follows:

1 designates root

2 designates timber

3 designates trunks

6. The symbol (-) followed by a number placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates the exclusion from that species or taxon of disignated geographically separated populations, sub-species, species or groups of species as follows:

- 101 Species which are not succulents

7. The symbol(+) followed by a number placed against the name of a species or higher taxon denotes that only designated geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in this Appendix as follows:

+201 All North American sub-species

+202 New Zealand species

+203 All species of the family in the Americas.
