VISIT OF UNITED STATES PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Foreign Affairs Minister André Ouellet today announced that Ambassador Madeleine Albright, the United States Permanent Representative to the United Nations, will make an official visit to Ottawa on May 9.

Ambassador Albright will meet with Prime Minister Jean Chrétien, Minister Ouellet, and officials of the Department of National Defence and the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade.

Discussions will focus on issues of common interest to the United States and Canada that are before the United Nations, including Haiti, the former Yugoslavia, Rwanda, peacekeeping, and the reform of the United Nations.
