PRAYERS

Mr. Kaplan, from the Standing Committee on Finance, Trade and Economic Affairs, presented the Seventh Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Friday, June 20, 1975, your Committee has considered Bill S-24, An Act to incorporate the Canadian Commercial and Industrial Bank, and has agreed to report it without amendment.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to this Bill (*Issues Nos. 57 and 58*) is tabled.

Mr. Whelan, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table,—Copies of (1) Statement made to the House of Commons on the First Session of the World Food Council, held in Rome, June 23-27, 1975.

(2) Statements made by the Minister of Agriculture to the World Food Council, on June 26 and 27, 1975. (English and French).—Sessional Paper No. 301-7/23.

Mr. Jelinek, seconded by Mr. Munro (Esquimalt-Saanich), by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-399, An Act to amend the Public Service Staff Relations Act and the Canada Labour Code to provide for the establishment of sector bargaining, which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Turner (Ottawa-Carleton), seconded by Mr. Sharp,—That this House approves in general the budgetary policy of the Government.

After further debate, the question being put on the motion, it was agreed to, on division.

The Order being read for the consideration of a Ways and Means Motion to amend the Income Tax Act (Sessional Paper No. 301-1/308B), laid upon the Table, Monday, June 23, 1975;

Mr. Turner (Ottawa-Carleton), seconded by Mr. Sharp, moved,—That the motion be concurred in.

And the question being put on the motion, it was agreed to.
