THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL C-9.

An Act to amend the Industrial Relations and Disputes Investigation Act (Application to Civil Service).

R.S., c. 152.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Section 38 of the *Industrial Relations and Disputes*Investigation Act is amended by adding thereto, immediately 5
after subsection (1) thereof, the following subsection:

Report binding on Crown and its employees.

- "(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), where the parties are Her Majesty in right of Canada and employees of Her Majesty in right of Canada, the recommendation of the Conciliation Board is binding on the parties and they 10 shall give effect thereto."
- 2. Section 55 of the said Act is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "55. Part I, excepting sections 21, 22, 23, 24 and 26 thereof, applies to bind Her Majesty in right of Canada 15 and the employees of Her Majesty in right of Canada."

Commencement.

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the expiration of the 31st day of March, 1960.
