Mr. Smith (Victoria-Carleton), seconded by Mr. Myers, moved,-That, in the opinion of this House it is expedient that the Government of Canada take all possible means and continue to use every effort to have the embargo, presently existing in Great Britain, against the entry of Canadian potatoes, removed by the British Department of Agriculture. After Debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion; it was

agreed to.
