Several Policemen Wounded, One Fatally, in Attack on Epsom Police Station.

London, June 18.—Unrest among Canadian soldiers in England because of continued postponement of home-ward sailings culminated last night in an attack by 400 Canadians on the Epsom police station. Several police-men were wounded, one so seriously that he died this morning. The pur-pose of the attack was to release a Canadian soldier who had been ar-rested. To avoid further trouble the police, released another Canadian' in whom the mob was not interested. During the last few days there has been trouble in the Canadian camp at Whitley, where the soldiers burned huts and did other camage, accord-ing to reports.
