HAMILTON NEWS NOTES

Griff Gets Three-Indians Being Civilized There-Scott's Limb Taken in One-Minute Matters.

Hamilton, Nov. 14. (Special.)-When John Hofman, a Conservative, had his head cut off at the custom house it was stated that he had been dismissed because there was nothing for him to do, and that no appointment would be made to fill his place. No appointment was made at the place, but since then some changes have been made, and in the shuffle a good thing has got a job. When W. Scott was awarded an leave of absence on account of sickness Dave Love was temporarily exchanged to fill his place. On Mr. Scott's return he did not resume his old position, but took the place of Andrew Martin, who was in the Customs Postoffice Department. Mr. Love took Mr. Scott's position, and Mr. Martin, who happens to be a Conservative, was notified that he would have to take Mr. Hofman's place.

Want an Elective Council. Members of the Six Nations Indians, whose reservation is on the mountain near this city, are demanding that hereditary chieftains be abolished, and that they elect their own chiefs to the governing council. The Indians have bought of A. G. Smith, a chief, who has not been popular with his fellow red men. Smith is a half-breed, and very intelligent. He is an honorary member of the Wentworth Historical Society.

His Leg Cut Off. Roger Spianey of Nova Scotia fell under the wheels of a train on the C. T. R. this morning, and one of his legs was crushed. He was taken to the General Hospital, where the limb was amputated. Spianey is a respectable iron worker in hard luck. He is about 30 years of age.

His back is sprained and his right leg badly broken in three places, caused by two flat cars passing over it. His left ankle is also broken. He was taken to Woodbridge, where Dr. McLean attended him, but it is thought the leg will have to be amputated. Mr. Ness is a young man and has a wife and small child here.
