

ITALIANS MAY SOON RETURN, PARIS BELIEF

Italian Premier's Speech Has Hopeful Ring.

CHINO - JAP SETTLEMENT

Plenary Session of Peace Conference on "Responsibility" Likely on Friday.

PARIS, April 30.—(By the Associated Press).—In spite of the optimistic views of the French press on the effect of Premier Orlando's speech to the Italian Parliament there were no indications in peace conference quarters today of any feeling that the situation had altered materially. The temperate tone of the Italian premier's address was commented upon favorably, but on the part of the council of three there were no signs of yielding from the previous position, as was suggested in dispatches from Rome.

If the Italians expect some proposal from Paris, they will find no response. In conference circles it is believed that the Italian delegates soon will return. In the meantime the work of the conference is proceeding uninterrupted toward the signing of the peace treaty. The situation was summed up in the remark of one of two, who said that it was inconceivable that the peace of the world should be prevented by one nation over one day.

Kiao-Chau Settled. Announcement was made shortly after 2 o'clock this afternoon that the dispute over Kiao-Chau had been settled. The peace treaty will provide that Germany must surrender Kiao-Chau to Japan. Japan will transfer the territory to China in due course. It is added that Japan's other agreement with China will not be affected.

The Belgians have asked the council of three for a first advance of two billion francs on their share of the German indemnity, according to French circles, and it appears that they have received definite and satisfactory assurances.

Plenary Session Tomorrow. It is reported that there may be a public plenary session of the conference Friday to discuss the "responsibility" article of the treaty.

The continued friendship of France for Italy was expressed by President Poincaré in a message today to the Italian people sent through the Association of France and Italy. The message said:

Italy and France, as closely as in war, will remain united in peace; nothing will separate them. A break in their friendship would be a disaster for Latin civilization and humanity. France remains faithful to its commitments, its sympathies and its traditions.

SENDS SEVEN COPS TO HOLD 2,500 MEN AND WOMEN STRIKERS

Detroit workers Get \$6 a Day and Not \$5 a Day.

[Special to The Advertiser.] DETROIT, Mich., April 30.—(By the Associated Press).—Strikers at the plant of the Wadsworth Manufacturing Company, on East Jefferson avenue, were brought up with a sharp turn today, when Mayor Coleman took a hand and ordered Police Commissioner Hughes to send an adequate force of police to the plant. The commissioner responded with seven lone officers, who had a busy time trying to hold in check 2,500 men and women.

When the mayor heard the trouble was continuing to take a walk over to police headquarters and ten minutes later a detachment of 70 blue coats were on their way.

The Wadsworth Company manufactures automobile bodies and has a force of nearly 2,000 men, who are paid a minimum of \$6 a day. The strikers say they are satisfied with their pay, but want the company to meet their committee to consider some changes. This the firm declines to believe the wages paid justifies it conducting its affairs in its own way.

Half Peace Treaty Already Cabled to State Department

PARIS, April 30.—Forty thousand words, about half of the peace treaty, have been cabled to the state department at Washington. The balance is going forward slowly.

The entire treaty will have been transmitted in a day or two for release for publication upon authorization by the conference.

GENEVA WILL BUILD PALACE FOR THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS

GENEVA, Tuesday, April 29.—A palace for the permanent seat of the league of nations will be constructed on one of several beautiful sites along Lake Geneva, near the city. In the meantime the city authorities will place the palace on the University, at the disposal of the delegates. Flags and other decorations were flown out in Geneva today, and tomorrow will be a public holiday. The state council will hold a special session in the morning in honor of the selection of Geneva as the seat of the league.

PARIS INTERCEPTS AN IMPORTANT BOLSHEVIST OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION

Lenine's Foreign Minister Advises Bela Kun, Hungarian Official, to Seize All Clothes, Factories, Banks, Newspapers, Food, and Starve the Bourgeoisie.

PARIS, April 29.—M. Tchitcherine, the Russian Bolshevik foreign minister, is unable to communicate with Munich, according to a wireless dispatch from him to Bela Kun, the Bolshevik foreign minister of the Hungarian Soviet Government, which has been picked up here. Bela Kun is asked to send a message to Munich, instructing the Soviet leaders there how to organize their Government.

ATLANTIC FLIERS MAKE READY, THEN DISAPPOINT CROWD

Change Their Minds About Venture at the Last Minute.

ST. JOHNS, Nfld., April 30.—A large crowd which had gathered to witness the herded start of the transatlantic flight was disappointed today, when Capt. Frederick P. Rayburn, the British aviator, and Harry G. Hawker, his Australian rival, were compelled by last-minute weather reports to abandon their plans. Both fliers had announced their intention of making the "hop off" today. Capt. Rayburn setting the hour for the start in his Martin plane for 3 o'clock, and Hawker announcing his Sopwith would get away fifteen minutes later.

Reports were received of a gale and heavy fog off the Grand Banks and a snowstorm at Belle Isle and the fliers agreed that it would be impossible to make the flight today.

ITALY'S BORROWING IN U. S. NOW \$1,571,500,000

WASHINGTON, April 30.—Italy was given a new loan today of \$50,000,000 by the treasury department to cover a number of obligations incurred by the Italian Government on contracts for war materials and foodstuffs from American producers. The extension brought Italy's total borrowings from the United States to \$1,571,500,000.

COMMUNIST TROOPS FALL BACK BEFORE RUMANIAN FORCES

Latter Continue Advance in Valleys Leading to Budapest.

BASLE, April 30.—(Havas Agency.)—Hungarian communist troops have withdrawn east of Karc Zug, 35 miles east-southeast of Budapest, before superior Rumanian forces, a Hungarian official statement from Budapest says. The Rumanians continue their advance down the river valleys leading to Budapest east of that city.

Flour Shortage Facing Canada, Millers Report

Even Predict That Wheat Substitutes May Again Be Rule.

TORONTO, April 30.—As an indirect result of the world food shortage it is thought not improbable among Toronto bakers and millers that it may be once more necessary to exercise the most rigid economy in the use of breadstuffs in Canada before the next wheat crop is harvested. The suggestion has even been made that it may be once more necessary to resort to the use of wheat substitutes in order to eke out the supply of flour.

MILLIONS OF DOLLARS WORTHLESS OIL STOCK SOLD ON N. Y. CURB

NEW YORK, April 30.—Sales of worthless oil stocks running into millions of dollars are believed to have been made on the New York curb market since January 1 and an investigation into the activities of brokers dealing in these "wildcat" securities will be started by the county district attorney's office.

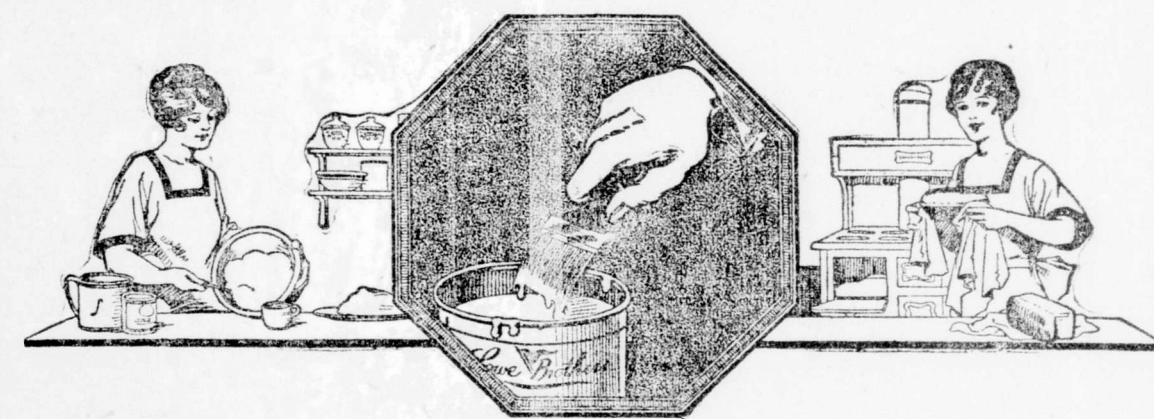
