duties of ory manThe resident medical officers have carried out their duties faithfully and well. The services of three of them, Drs. Bazin, Byers and Kinghorn, have been retained for a second year, and the outgoing members, Drs. Fisk, Gorrell, Manchester and Rimer carry with them the best wishes of the committee and medical board for success in their future careers. The vacancies thus created have been filled by the appointments of Drs. Anthony, Cowie, Hogle, Kerry and Saunders. A new appointment has been created of externe in pathology, to which Dr. J. A. Williams has been appointed.

The Training School for nurses, under the skilful guidance of Miss Livingston, continues to give universal satisfaction. The average number of nurses in training was 43. During the year 290 applications were received; fifty of these were received on the usual two months' probation, of whom 39 were accepted. Since the inauguration of the school 72 nurses have graduated and 61, or 85 per cent., are actually engaged in the active duties of their profession. An analysis shows that 45 are devoting themselves to private nursing, 16 are employed in hospital work in Canada and the United States, eight are at home, three are married, and one is studying abroad.
