

away any of the timber or wood growing on any part of the Glebe without the authority of the Church Wardens and Vestry, in the manner heretofore provided in the twenty-eighth section of this Act. *Carried.*

That section 37 be passed. *Carried.*

That section 38 be passed, with the alteration of the words "upon such election" to "upon the election of the Church Wardens." *Carried.*

Mr. W. M. Jarvis moved to adjourn the debate till to-morrow, Friday, to be taken up as the first business in order. *Carried.*

On motion, the Synod adjourned till to-morrow, Friday, at 11 A. M.
