Referring to your letter of the 29th July last, asking for more accurate information respecting the road on the Indian reserve at *Jeune Lorrette* which the Indians desire to reserve for their own use, I beg to return you the file of papers (No. 99, 200) in the matter, on the face of which you will find a letter of the 23rd ultimo from the Indian Agent at *La Jeune Lorrette*, giving all the information which he can procure on the subject.

I shall be obliged if you will now advise me whether it would be legal for the Indians to exclude the public from the road in question.
