Referring to your letter of the 23rd July last, asking for more accurate information respecting the road on the Indian reserve at Jeune Lorette which the Indians desire to reserve for their own use, I beg to return you the file of record No. 99, 200 in the matter, on the face of which you will find a letter of the 23rd ultmo from the Indian Agent at La Jeune Lorette, giving all the information which he can procure on the subject.

I shall be obliged if you will now advise me whether it would be legal for the Indians to exclude the public from the road in question.
