REGULATIONS FOR 1880-81.\*

MATRICULATION.

1. After 1st January, 1879, the Matriculation Examinations will be held in Toronto and Kingston alternately. The examination at Toronto will be held on the first Tuesday and Wednesday after Good Friday. The examination at Kingston on the third Tuesday and Wednesday in August in each year, and both the Matriculation Examiners shall take part in every Matriculation Examination. In this examination writing and dictation will be included: correct spelling and legible writing will be considered imperative.

2. The rules laid down for conducting the Professional Examinations shall be observed in all respects at the Matriculation Examination.

3. Every Student, before his Professional studies begin, must pass a satisfactory examination in the following subjects before the Examiners of the Council:—

- a. English Language, including Grammar and Composition.
- b. Arithmetic.
- c. Algebra, including Simple Equations.
- d. Geometry, first two books of Euclid.
- e. Latin, Translation and Grammar.

And upon one of the following subjects (of which Students are recommended to select either Natural Philosophy or one of the Modern Languages), the Candidate having the option of naming the subject upon which he† will be examined, viz.:

\* Information with regard to any changes which the Medical Council may make at its coming Session may be obtained from the Secretary of the School after the meeting in July.

† The masculine pronoun is used here and throughout the "Regulations" with reference to "Students" and "Candidates;" nevertheless, these terms are to be construed as applicable to either sex.
