



Three years ago Mrs. Bradshaw was the Democratic candidate for assembly in Bergen county.

WANTS TO LEND TO SOVIETS.

Argentine Government Asks Congress to Vote a \$5,000,000 Peco Loan. Buenos Aires, Sept. 15.—The Argentine government has sent a message to Congress asking in view of the desperate condition of Russia, authorization to lend the Soviet government \$5,000,000 pesos, to be repaid "when circumstances permit, and without interest." FIND TREE 24 FEET AROUND.

Measurer Wins First Prize in Contest for Long Island. A big tree contest in which prizes were offered by the Brooklyn Botanic Garden for records set in of the biggest trees on Long Island, the measurements being carefully verified, has come to a close, and the following prizes have been awarded. First prize for a sycamore tree twenty-four feet in circumference on the property of James H. Hill at Wheatley Hills, awarded to Herbert Simonson, Glen Head. Second prize for a white oak tree nineteen feet, seven inches in circumference on the farm of Paul Costermale, Stony Brook, divided among C. P. Miller of Stony Brook, C. C. Gregson of Setauket and Harold Smith of Setauket, all of whom measured the same tree on March 11.

ADMITS KILLING TWO GIRLS.

Kansas City Father Confesses Throwing Bodies of Daughters into River. Kansas City, Sept. 15.—A confession that he had killed his two daughters and thrown their bodies into the Missouri River was made by Tony Dinello of Kansas City, Kan., to Harry T. Zimmer, chief of police, and several detectives. Dinello was arrested after the second of the bodies had been taken from a sandspit near Napoleon, thirty miles downstream by a fisherman. The girls were eleven and thirteen years old. Dinello's relatives became suspicious some days ago when they visited him and he gave them conflicting explanations of the girls' absence. About the same time a body was found in a sack and, although it was not then identified, it was established that the girl had been hit on the head. The second body showed the same kind of a fracture. Both girls were dressed in cheap wrappers and wore no shoes or stockings. Both sacks into which their bodies were placed were similarly tied at the top and by strings around the necks.
