of prices. The retail prices of eggs hit new low marks for the winter today when 6,000,000 dozen were dumped on the market. Fresh eggs retail from thirty-nine to forty cents and storage eggs at twenty-nine cents. Wholesale prices dropped 5 1/2 cents a dozen.

Despatches from Chicago state that speculators in eggs, unable to pay their margins, have lost \$900,000 in the crash.
