There is building in British Columbia a craft 250 feet long, 60 feet beam, 36 feet draft, and with a displacement of about 9,000 tons, which is ship and cargo in one. It will be simply a cargo of 6,000,000 feet of Douglas fir, built and bolted together in the shape of a ship, with engines in its midst and with poop and fore-cle on top. It will be a sailing ship with auxiliary motors driving twin screws. When launched it is but a raft, on which timber will be built up loads in three tiers, held together and bolted by cross beams, and stem and stern will be alike. On arrival, it will simply be taken apart and all will be marketable except the pieces through which bolts have passed, the deck-houses and the engines.
