METHODISTS TO HAVE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Proceedings of the Ecumenical
Conference—Home Religion
and Religious Education

Toronto, Oct. 12.—(Special).—At the session this morning of the Ecumenical conference, one British representative spoke of the prospect of church union in Canada. He seemed to feel that the appearance of the Methodist name would be an awful calamity. One of his own brethren replied by saying that Methodism is not one of the eternities of God, but probably only the temporary means of carrying on his work. What matters the name if the spirit of the church remains?

The English delegates evidently believe in expressing themselves freely on every subject. When a speaker pleases them, they exclaim: "Hear, hear," and are quite as ready to say "No," as they are to say "Yes." Some of the Canadians think that the Englishmen have declared their opposition to a little too strongly on the subject of the organic union of the churches that is contemplated in Canada, but it should be remembered that these men have been accustomed to speak their minds freely, especially in conference. They are a splendid body of men and it has been a pleasure to meet and hear them.

Babes Born Sinless.

The theme of this morning, Home Religion, and Religious Education in the home, afforded opportunity of emphasizing some very practical truths relating to the life of the child. The first speaker declared that children came into the world as members of God's Kingdom, and the gospel of religion should be applied to them. The conference accepted this position, with practical unanimity. Forty years ago there would have been strong opposition to any such statement.

It is quite evident from the descriptions given by the English delegates, that poverty and wretchedness exist in great cities of the land, to an extent that is unknown in America. The American cities, however, have the great problem of the foreign element to deal with, which complicates the situation and adds not a little to the work of home evangelism.

An Advisory Commission.

Toronto, Oct. 12.—A Methodist international advisory commission was established by action of the Ecumenical Methodist Conference in this city today. With a membership of 100 of the present delegates, to be appointed later, it will act during the decennial interim between the meetings of the conference, while its function will be chiefly advisory in such church and denominational matters as may come within its scope. It will also attempt to use the influence of the 20,000,000 Methodists it represents in the forwarding of certain world movements for peace and justice.

The work of the church with relation to young people was discussed at tonight's session. A paper on The Conditions and Needs of Young People's Societies, by Bishop J. F. Berry, of Buffalo, who was unable to be present, was read; Prof. D. J. Jordan, of Kittery (N. C.), spoke on Special Work of Young People in the Church, and Rev. L. Hudson, of the Methodist church of New Zealand, considered The Church and the Recreation of the Young People.

MANUFACTURERS END THEIR SESSIONS

John Palmer, of Fredericton, a Vice-President—The Matter of Express Rates

Toronto, Oct. 12.—The Canadian Manufacturers' Association concluded its business sessions today, after passing a number of resolutions.

A committee was appointed to investigate the question of workmen's compensation and to make future legislation along this line.

Industrial co-operation was endorsed, and a resolution was passed endorsing the extra provincial company legislation in the different provinces of Canada. It was denounced as unreasonable and destructive of sound business conditions.

Uniformity of provincial laws was strongly urged.

The work of the dominion conservation commission was warmly endorsed.

Following officers were elected: President, N. Curry, Montreal; first vice-president, R. S. Doolley, Toronto; Ontario vice-president, R. McLoughlin, Ontario; Quebec vice-president, C. B. Gordon, Montreal; Manitoba vice-president, M. B. Christie, Winnipeg; British Columbia vice-president, Jas. Ramsey, Nova Scotia vice-president, J. P. Edwards, Londonderry (N. S.); New Brunswick vice-president, John Palmer, Fredericton; Alberta and Saskatchewan vice-president, W. H. Clarke, Edmonton; treasurer, George Booth, Toronto.

Toronto, Oct. 12.—Good news was given to the Canadian Manufacturers' Association convention this morning, when Henry Bertin, chairman of the railway and transportation committee, told about the new schedule of rates as filed by the express companies. The board of railway commissioners had enlarged the time for filing the traffic until Oct. 15. In some of the tariffs there was a marked reduction shown, the largest being in the west itself, also between the east and west.

There is no change in the present rate between Montreal, Hamilton and St. John (N. B.), and Brandon, between London, Hamilton, Toronto and Winnipeg, and between St. John and Winnipeg.

A short discussion arose, on the suggestion of R. D. Patten, in connection with the possibilities of the post office, as compared with express companies. The post office should have a uniform rate of three cents a pound, with a limit of 25 pounds, which was nine times the rate obtained in Germany, where the rate was one-half of a cent a pound with maximum of 110 pounds. A ten pound parcel carried anywhere in England for 20 cents. It would cost \$1.60 in Canada.

"Why should we not cut out the intermediate profits of these middlemen?" said Mr. Fairbairn. "Get into direct communication with the farmer. We have the machinery in the post office system. The middleman of middlemen stands between the manufacturer and the customer. Let us go over the heads of the jobbers and middlemen."

MORE SENATORS FROM THE WEST

Government to Increase Representation by Nine—Redistribution Will Mean 96 in Senate

Ottawa, Oct. 12.—The Borden government has in view one very convenient and happy way out of the difficulty of finding places for the foremost names on the long list of party workers now anxiously awaiting rewards in the shape of government appointments.

The representation of the west in the senate is to be increased. When the tonnage bill was passed in 1905 establishing the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan, it was provided that each province shall be represented in the senate by four members provided that such representation may, after the completion of the next decennial census, be from time to time increased to six by act of parliament.

The government will carry out the provisions of the act and at the same time reallocate the seats in the senate. British Columbia and Manitoba in the senate also by six members each. British Columbia now has only three senators and Manitoba four.

The new senate redistribution will give 24 members to the west, leaving 24 members to the east. For British Columbia G. H. Cowan, M. P., and Sir Charles Herbert Tupper, of Vancouver, and Hon. Robert Green of Victoria, an ex-member of the McBride government, are mentioned.

For Alberta the names of John Herrop and C. A. Magrath, the defeated Conservative candidates in Medicine Hat and Lethbridge, respectively, and L. G. McCarthy, M. P., for Calgary, are suggested.

In Saskatchewan, R. S. Lake, ex-M. P., for Qu'Appelle, is pretty sure to be provided for.

In Manitoba, Alex. Haggart, M. P., of Winnipeg, who is giving up his seat for Hon. Robert Rogers, will be entitled to one of the new senatorships in case he does not immediately secure the vacant seat left by the late Senator Chevier. If Mr. Haggart is appointed, when the new seat might be claimed by Glen Campbell, ex-M. P., and Hon. A. A. C. Lavigne, ex-M. P.

In any event there will be a big scramble for the coveted appointments. The act creating the new senatorships was probably held over until the second session of the new parliament, when the redistribution bill will also be put through.

Victory For the Women

San Francisco, Oct. 12.—Woman suffrage has triumphed in California. Returns last today wiped out the majority previously recorded against the amendment, and since this turns the margin in favor of the amendment has increased steadily.

ITALIANS TAKE UP THE FIGHT ON LAND

Tripoli, Oct. 12.—General Canera, commander in chief of the Italian expedition has decided to act quickly, and it is believed that the troops under him will march immediately against the positions occupied by the Turks. A reconnaissance of the desert today disclosed the central body of the Turkish troops with field guns not far from the city.

Nineteen more Italian transports escorted by warships and carrying the second division of the troops, arrived this morning. The men were hastily landed. This division is 15,000 strong and there are now 22,000 Italian soldiers on the coast of Tripoli for its defence. Not only is the Italian position now safeguarded against surprise, but an effective occupation of the interior can begin.

Consular reports have reached the Italian government stating that thirty Italian laborers employed on the Hodejia railroad, on the boundary line between Egypt and Syria, were massacred at Kras, Syria, early in October.

DISSOLVE ELECTRICAL COMBINE IN STATES

Washington, Oct. 12.—By a sweeping decree entered in the United States Circuit Court at Toledo today, the backbone of the so-called Electrical Trust was broken and, in the judgment of Attorney-General William C. Clegg, the government was equipped with precedents of genuine value in its prosecution of the electrical combine.

Meeting the government's charges that the trust controlled the electric power business of the country, regulating by agreement the prices at which all lamps were sold, the decree severed all relationship between the General Electric Company and the National Electric Lamp Company. The latter concern and all of its subsidiaries are ordered dissolved.

MUNICIPALITIES UNION BUSINESS

Officials Elected Yesterday and Resolutions Adopted—Movement for Juvenile Courts

Newcastle, N. B., Oct. 12.—The meetings of the Union of Municipalities were brought to a close today.

This morning Messrs. Kelley and Sidgill's motion was carried asking the legislature to establish a children's aid society and juvenile courts and take other measures needed to protect child life, and pledging the municipalities to pay the expenses of the same.

On motion of the same delegates a general law was recommended giving public bodies the right to expropriate lands for public purposes.

Ald. H. H. Stuart, of Newcastle, read a paper on Municipal Taxation, advocating the abolition of taxes on improvements, personal property and income, and the abolition or reduction of the poll tax, and the raising of municipal revenue from a tax on land values; the abolition of all property qualification now required of voters, and by vote of a large majority, when adopted, was adopted by a large majority.

This afternoon Ald. Stuart's resolution, seconded by Ald. Butler, favoring asking the legislature for power for each municipality to change its taxation system on a majority vote of qualified ratepayers voting, was adopted by a large majority.

His second motion, seconded by Ald. John, and Ald. Butler, favoring asking the legislature for power for each municipality to abolish the income and property qualification, or either, as a condition of candidates for office of county councillor, alderman and mayor, approved by the executive, and by vote of a large majority, was not allowed to come up for discussion.

On motion of Mayor Reilly and Ald. Potts it was resolved to issue upon the government the necessity of providing amendments to the introduction of bills, for legislation, especially when such seek the right to use and control any public works, or to interfere with the business of the municipality affected by such legislation, and that such be in addition to the measures now required.

On motion of Councillors Cochrane and Donovan, a resolution passed favoring the holding of the county elections on the same day and extending the term to three years.

The election of officers resulted as follows: President, Councillor Sidall, Port Elgin; vice-president, Ald. Potts, St. Stephen; secretary-treasurer, J. W. McCready, Fredericton (re-elected); executive, Ald. Potts, Fredericton; Councillor McMillan, Prince William; Councillor Cochrane, St. Martins; Alderman Hiltz, Millville; Town Clerk, Murray, Sackville; Mayor, Peltola, Newcastle; Alderman Price, Moncton; Alderman Potts, St. John; Alderman Alexander, Campbellton.

On motion of Aldermen Wallace and Polley, Alderman Stuart's paper on taxation was ordered engrossed on the minutes.
