BOLSHEVIKI

ENTITLED TO NO CONSIDERATION

London, Nov. 18—Replying to an allusion by Arthur Ponsonby, M. P., that there were rumors of Great Britain sending a military expedition to Russia, Lord Robert Cecil, under secretary of state for foreign affairs, said today in the house of commons that he could give no information without consulting with the war office.

He reviewed the grave offences of the Bolsheviki government, saying: "If they had been committed by any civilized government, Great Britain would be justified in seeking redress by force of arms." He declared that the Bolsheviki government was "entitled to no consideration whatever from the British government."
