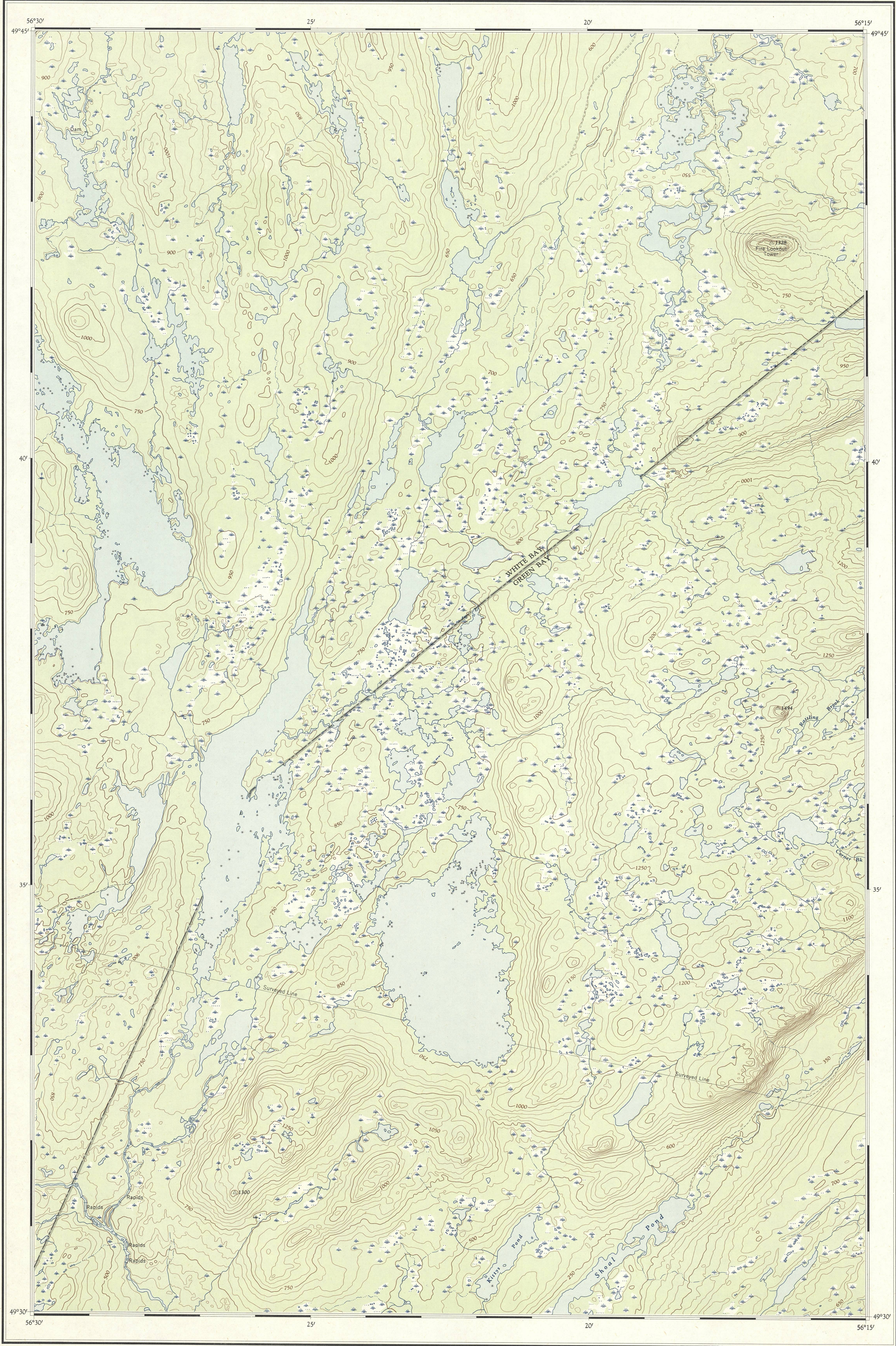

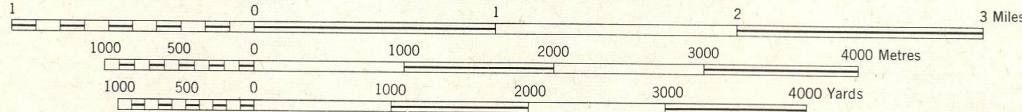
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 30°36' WEST
