Musician Declares it a Marvelous Tonic in Healing Today.

JAZZ IS EVIL SPIRIT OF MUSIC

Is Expression of Devastating Spirit Which Has Fallen on the World.

Chicago, May 27.—Music the universal language, was described as a marvelous tonic in a new sphere of healing today. It was at the opening meeting of the music trades convention, 5,000 men and women being in attendance.

"Jazz is the evil spirit of music, declared Dr. Frank E. Morton, chairman of the music industries committee.

"Jazz," said Dr. Morton, "expresses hysteria and incites to idleness, revelry, dissipation, destruction, discord and chaos. It accords with the devastating, volcanic spirit that has burst forth over the world in the last six years.

"With 'Home, Sweet Home,' silenced home itself tends to disappear. With home swallowed up in the care and the great stabilizing centre of society is lost."
