For every hundred of Newland Filly, containing fix score, three pence. For every hundred of Hake, containing fix score, six pence. For every hun= died of Conger Dulce, lip pence. For every Tun of Pilchards, one pound five Chillings. Foz every Barrel of Winter Herrings, White, full, and Packed, eight pence. For every Last of Winzter Herrings, White, full, and Packed, contains ing twelve Barrels, eight spillings. Fozevery Last of Winter Herrings, White, full, and un= packed, or Scalticks, containing eighteen Bar= rels, eight Chillings. For every Barkel of Winster Herrings, White, Cotten, and Packed, four pence. For every Last of winter Herrings, white, shotten, and Packed, containing twelve Bar= rels, four Chillings. For every Last of Win= ter Herrings, White, shotten, and unpacked, oz Scalticks, containing eighteen Barrels, four chillings. For every Cade of winter Herrings, red, and full, containing the hundred, four pence. For every Last of Winter Herrings, red, and full, containing twenty Cades, or ten thoufand, lix hillings.
