Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that Inspector
 Burnett of the H. B. C. visited
 this Agency on the 6th inst
 and examined some of the cattle
 and pronounced the disease
 black leg. He left instructions
 to feed light and destroy all
 carcasses as soon as the
 animal dies as the disease
 is very contagious. The
 disease so far in British
 Columbia is confined to the
 Reserve as only 2 or 3
 animals have died on the
 other Reserves. The disease
 is confined to the Reserve
 and has not yet spread
 to the other Reserves.
