Replying to your cable of August seventh Canada  
prepared to give Australia all advantages of her British  
preference including preference of three cents per pound  
on raisins and dried currants such concession equivalent  
to fourteen pounds sterling per long ton STOP Canada  
will also introduce resolution into House of Commons to  
provide that the British preferential and general tariff  
rates will be amended on the items specified in the  
memorandum handed Oakley namely butter cheese meat  
canned meat tallow dried fruit other under item ninety  
three eggs lard honey canned fruits beeswax essential  
oils glue and gelatine canned vegetables fresh pears STOP
