



Dear Chief,-

In reply to your letter of the 29th ultimo I beg to inform you that the Canadian Northern Railway has made a deposit of \$5000.00 with the Department on account of its Right of way through the Tyendinaga Indian Reserve. On the 1st. Mr. J. B. Stainton, Indian Agent, was instructed to permit entry on the Reserve for construction purposes and he had been already instructed to make the necessary valuations of land and damages in connection with the said Right of way.
