Ottawa, 31st December, 1910.

S1r,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the17th instar in further reference to the sum of \$500.00 bequeathed from a white man named Angus Hamont to an Indian woman named Emma; and in reply I beg to inform you that you should instruct the Indian Agent Mr. Brown, to forward to the Depar a statement of all receipts and disbursements, up to date, which he made in connection with the receipt by him of the amount in question. He should also forward to the Depart ment the balance of the money which he has on bland (or in the Bank). All further amounts which Mr. Brown receives for credit of Emma should also be forwarded to the Department. When the moneys are received they will b places to her credit in the saving account All accounts for supplies furnished the woman should be forwarded to the Department. The accounts should be properly certified by the Indian Agent and when received here, they will be paid from the amount standing to the woman's credit.
