that due to the expenditure of petrol and time necessary to proc o the field where these officers are now posted, the Court does not ind it expedient to interview the several officers, who were on egimental Duty at the times suggested by Captain R.F. Bastedo, 18th an Armd Car Regt (12D), in order to determine who was negligent in not elaying, to the Cooks and Butchers Trng Wing, the telephone message sporting the absence whithout leave of A 19383 Pte Black, G.E.
