Absenting himself without leave, in that he, at Haig Lines Barracks, Crookham Crossroads, Aldershot Command, absented himself without leave from 2330 hours 30 Sep 41 until apprehended by the Civil Police at the Immigration Office, Cardiff, Wales at about 1630 hours 6 Oct 41, dressed in plain clothes, thereby incurring cost of apprehension and return from Cardiff, Wales to the extent of £1-10-0.
Time absent 5 days, 17 hours.
Under close arrest from 1630 hours 6 Oct 41.
