

It will thus be seen, that the female is not unlike that of *Eubranchipus gelidus*, having, however, one more abdominal segment and three dorsal processes; but the male is easily distinguished from that of the latter by the lack of frontal organ (process), and the quite different claspers, etc. From *A. bungei* the female *A. stefanssoni* is distinguished by the greater transverse diameter




Fig. 6. *Artemiopsis stefanssoni* (Johansen). Female, 8-11 mm. long. Cotypes. Bernard Harbour, N.W.T. October 6, 1915. About $\times 50$.
