

**STIPENDIARY MAGISTRATE'S COURT**—established for the purpose of adjudicating in cases of Small Debts. Its sittings are held in the City Hall, on the first Wednesday in each month, with power to adjourn to the following day. The last day of issuing summonses for the monthly sittings, is the Monday week previous to the first said Wednesday. The Act gives jurisdiction to the extent of \$64 in case of debt and trover, and to \$16 in slander, detinue and replevin.
