## What does your cream separation service cost you per year?

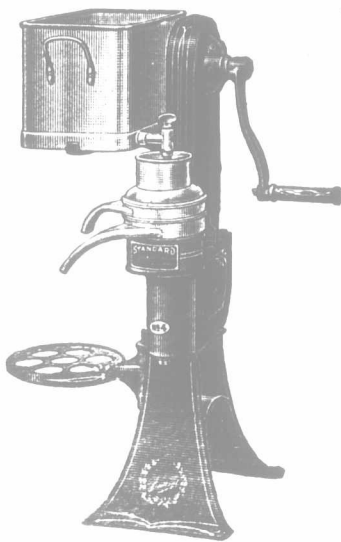

### Comparison of Standard and Ordinary Machines
