## COBALT ORE SHIPMENTS.

The following are the Cobalt ore shipments, in pounds,  
for the week ended May 30th:—O'Brien, 254,810; Nipissing,  
14,220; Trethewey, 124,850; Silver Queen, 110,310; Drum-  
mond Mine, 56,260; Coniagas, 62,030; McKinlay-Darragh,  
66,540; La Rose, 60,000; total, 919,020 pounds, or 459 tons.  
The total shipments since January 1st are now 14,691,492  
pounds or 7,345 tons.

The total shipments for the year 1907 were 29,981,010  
pounds, or 14,040 tons. In 1904 the camp produced 158 tons,  
valued at \$136,217; in 1905, 2,144 tons, valued at \$1,473,196;  
in 1906, 5,129 tons, valued at \$3,900,000. The estimated value  
of the ore shipments for 1907 is between \$10,000,000 and \$12,  
000,000.
