CHURCH UNION

Though the vote is taken in the Presbyterian General Assembly at Winnipeg on the question of forming an organic union of the Presbyterian, Methodist, and Congregational bodies in Canada was favorable thereto, it does not promise an unchallenged consummation of the project. After three days of very strenuous debate, not at times without considerable heat, in which the conflicting views of "unionists" and "anti-unionists" were fully stated, the vote in favor of proceeding to the consummation of union at a certain definite time after the conclusion of the war was carried by a very large majority. Both sides were in earnest, and at no time was the issue at stake regarded as a purely academic question. The matter in various forms had been before the congregation and Church courts for several years. Of late the opposition on the part of the membership of the Church was undoubtedly growing, and the advocates of union appear to have made up their minds that the time and place were admirably suited to commit the Church as far as possible to the step. In the progress of the debate various attempts were made to postpone all action for the present or to leave the consummation of union to some indefinite period after the war, but these efforts to preserve a measure of harmony in the congregations were all voted down.

High Shorthorn Prices

Continually it is proven that today is a red-letter one in the cattle-raising industry, dairy or beef. Last week 70 head of cattle averaging \$400 each were sold at J. A. Watts, Elora, Ont. It was one of the biggest shorthorn sales held in Canada, record prices being realized. The highest price was realized for Clipper the Fourth, a 2-year-old, which brought \$1,125. Four or five cows brought over \$1000 each.

The God of freedom serving!

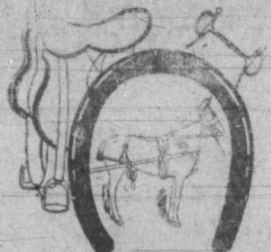
Or out on the tortured fields of France,

Synopsis of Canadian Land Regulation

THE sole head of a family over 18 years old, instead a quarter section of Dominion land in Manitoba, or in Alberta. Applicant in person at the Dominion Lands Agency for the district, proxy may be made at any Lands Agency (but not sub-certain conditions).

Duties—Six months residence cultivation of the land in each year. A homesteader may acquire title to his homestead of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required. Residence is performed in the homestead. In certain districts a homestead of 160 acres is required. A homestead section alongside his homestead of 80 acres.

Duties—Six months residence of three years after earning patent; also 50 acres extra. Pre-emption patent may be soon as homestead patent, conditions. A settler who has exhausted his right may take a purchase of certain districts. Pre-emption—Must reside out of three years, cultivate 50 acres a house worth \$300. The art of cultivation is required in case of rough, stony land. Live stock may be used for cultivation under certain conditions.
