W. P. A.

We are requested by the Newfoundland War Contingent, Association to remind Branches of the W. P. A. that when sending parcels to our soldiers and sailors overseas, one parcel only should be posted under the one cover.

Not adhering to this regulation causes trouble and expense to the authorities in England. Each parcel should have a "statement of contents" plainly written on the outside, and should be free of dutiable goods (such as tobacco and cigarettes) to ensure their passing at the Post Office without opening or enquiry.
