LONDON, England, Dec. 19 .- Ancient connections between British royalty and the City of London have been reaffirmed by the ceromious admission of the Duke of York, King George's second son, to the "Worshipful Company of Merchant Taylors," the first honorary mem-ber of which was Edward III., who reigned some 800 years ago.

After the swearing in, the duke said, that having been previously admitted to the drapers, the mercers and the needlemakers' guild, he was happy in rounding off his connection with the clothing trade by becoming a "taylor" also; but he confessed that he was glad he did not live in the days of James I., when the banquet given in honor to a new member included a dish of owls and cuckoos.


