OUTLAW BLANKET CAPTURED.

The Highwayman who Robbed R. C. Conacher in the Toils.

VANOVER, R. C., July 2.—Blanket, a notorious outlaw, who has been holding out in the Cariboo (R. C.) stage, has been captured, after a desperate struggle, by the provincial police. Blanket was traced by gully sack mask which he stole from a boarding house.

He was independently wealthy from robbing Chinese gold miners, whom he compelled to work for him in lonely districts as his slaves, sometimes forcing them to break rocks without food or drink for 24 hours.

Having served his apprenticeship with the Chinese he started out as a highwayman and robbed an express company of several thousand dollars in gold dust.
