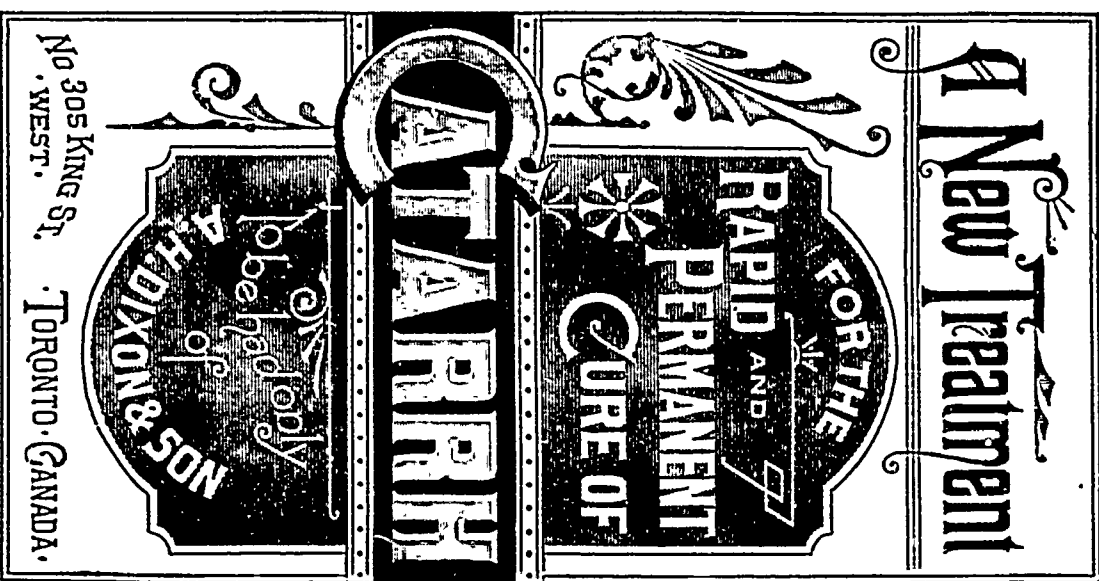


WHAT IS CATARRH?
