CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIC.

The close of September finds lumber prices steady after the several advances that have been put into effect during the season. With almost the entire season's production manufactured and ready for the market, it would not be surprising if prices should show a tendency to recede from their high point; but the only tendency in this direction is confined to one locality and to one class of trade. In Western Ontario some shading of prices on the lower grades of white pine in carload lots is reported, but it has not been of such an extent as to cause the trade much concern. There is really no reason to cut prices at the present time, as the demand is of average volume and a good trade seems assured throughout the fall and winter months. Of course, there will be quiet periods. In Toronto it has not yet been possible to advance prices on good. lumber to a basis corresponding with
