considered necessary for the carrying out of the purposes of this Act, and all matters incidental thereto.

All regulations made under the provisions of this section shall be published in the Royal Gazette.

The Superintendent of Education shall make an annual detailed report of the moneys expended and received under the provisions of this Act. Such report shall be presented to the Legislature of part of the Legislature of the Legislatu to the Legislature as part of the Report of the Department of Education.

The purpose, rules and methods of the Bureau were public in full in the Sugarlished in full in the Supplement to the April 1915 Journal of Education, a copy of which Education, a copy of which was sent to each school section in the Province, as well as to each dealer in school books.

The following important points should be noted:-

To the Public.

The object the Government has in view in establishing the Bureau, is to cheapen the cost of school books to the people, and at the same time allows for and at the same time allow a fair profit to those who have wish retailing these books in the retailing these books in the past or who in the future may the to do so.
