Specific proposals will be made known through diplomatic channels, and for this purpose Mexico will provide the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada (AUCC) with information as to high-priority areas and details concerning the projects it wishes to see undertaken, within a period of not more than 90 days.

2. The ANUIES and the AUCC offer their cooperation for facilitating contacts and relations between universities and institutions of higher education in the two countries.

Proposals will be presented through diplomatic channels as they are formulated, with a minimum of six months' advance notice.

3. Each country will promote attendance by its specialists at conferences, seminars, and meetings held in the other country, and for this purpose will provide the corresponding information.

Available details will be made known through diplomatic channels.

4. Mexico's Ministry of External Relations (SRE) and Canada's Department of External Affairs will exchange teachers and specialists in the social sciences and history to give talks on such topics as Mexican-Canadian relations, foreign policy, et cetera.

Available details will be made known through diplomatic channels.

5. The two countries will study the possibility of exchanging archives specialists.
