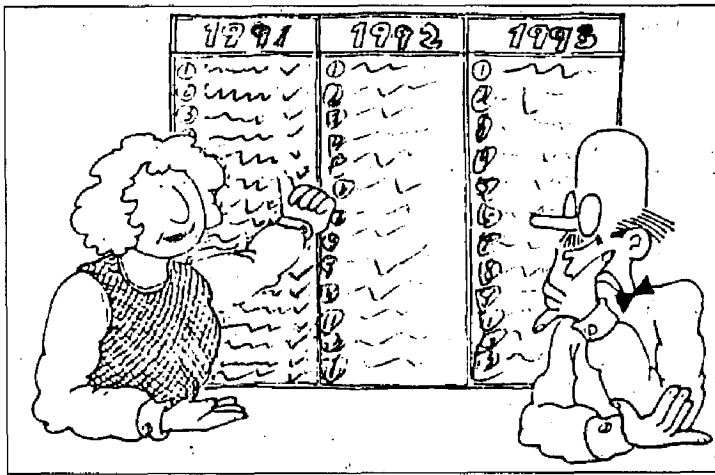

Last Update



Since September, the Corporate Review Implementation Team (CRIT) has been working with CRX to put in place the recommendations of last year's Corporate Review and continue the long term strategy for the changes the Department will face in the 1990s. It has been an extraordinary year in many ways. At the same time that we were responding to the need for change within EAITC, the world around us continued to astound.

In spite of the unexpected developments which the Department has had to cope with, including further serious resource reductions, the implementation process

has carried on and most of the innovations and improvements planned in the Corporate Review are now in place. Although the work of renewal will continue, with specific Branches responsible for carrying each part forward, June 30 marked the formal end of the Corporate Review process as well as the end of CRX and the CRIT.

It also means the end of the *Corporate Review Update*. In this, our final edition, we want to recognize the tremendous support and assistance that we, in CRX, have received throughout the past year. To put in place the decisions announced in June 1990 required not only a commitment, but an enormous amount of energy, effort, imagination and risk.
