Sharing CANADIAN EXPERTISE

In helping countries recover from conflict, there is often a need for experts that can react quickly to help with humanitarian and other activities. The Canadian Resource Bank for Democracy and Human Rights (CANADEM) fills that need. It is a roster of Canadian civilian experts that responds quickly to international requests in countries as diverse as Rwanda and Afghanistan.

Combatting TRANSNATIONAL CRIME

The drug trade. Money laundering. Weapons trafficking. With the opening of borders and the growing sophistication of technology, transnational crime is a growing threat to public safety. To combat this problem, the Program has provided Canadian expertise to countries in Latin America and Asia.

Women BUILDING PEACE

The civil war in Sudan has had a devastating effect on women. Many have not only lost their homes and livelihoods, but also a voice in decision-making. A National Women's Conference brought together over 150 Sudanese women to address their role in resolving conflict and rebuilding peace.
