is the responsibility we have, each and everyone of us, towards our fellow men. We have recognized this responsibility within the context of our communities and national societies and we are now reaching the stage where this recognition is being increasingly reflected on the international plane. I look upon international cooperation as a natural extension of the concept of brotherhood.

I believe that, as Canadians, we have a special part to play in advancing this broader concept of brotherhood. The qualities of understanding and tolerance which are inherent in that concept are qualities which have been and will continue to be instrumental in helping us to enlarge the dimensions of our national life. It is in this spirit that I would warmly endorse the observance of Brotherhood Week and ask all Canadians to support it in word and in deed.
