NIGER'S MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND COOPERATION TO VISIT CANADA

The Honourable Monique Landry, Minister for External Relations, announced today that His Excellency Mr. Mahamane Sani Bako, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of the Republic of Niger, will be in Canada on an official visit from May 19 to 21, 1987. Mr. Sani Bako will be accompanied by representatives of the Foreign Affairs and Cooperation Department, the Ministry of Planning and the National Council for Development.

Mr. Sani Bako will be in Ottawa on May 19 and 20th to meet with Mrs Landry and other representatives of the Canadian Government. He will then proceed to Quebec to meet representatives of the Provincial Government. Discussions in Ottawa are expected to concentrate on bilateral relations, the Francophone Summit and an exchange of views about recent developments on the African continent.
