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CANADIAN SUPPLIER WINS "BLUE RIBBON" AWARD

John McDermid, Member of Parliament for Brampton-Georgetown, on behalf of International Trade Minister John C. Crosbie, announced today that the Microwave Division of Varian Canada Inc., of Georgetown, Ontario, was presented with the first Blue Ribbon Contractor award by the U.S. Army's Communication Electronics Command (CECOM), at a ceremony held on June 30th at CECOM Headquarters in Fort Monmouth, New Jersey.

In offering his congratulations to the firm, Mr. McDermid remarked that this award is especially significant, considering that a Canadian supplier was chosen first among all North American suppliers to CECOM.

The award is limited to those firms that achieve at least 90% "on-time" delivery with no more than two defects in items delivered over a twelve-month period.
