  - Asking lengthy question may run risk of making speech, 1432
  - Can have floor later to answer remarks, 2357
  - Cannot answer questions that have not been asked, 3371
  - Cannot take the floor, only on a point of order or to ask a question, 2736
  - Has already spoken, may not ask question, 2436
  - Inaudible remarks, 1783, 1818
  - Latitude to new members, extending, 905, 1379-80
  - May be questioned only if in charge of a committee, 1381
  - Member for Bellechasse named, 233
  - Mover of motion may reply to question but that will close debate, 2436
  - Must speak from own place, 296, 1396, 1843
  - No one may insist on the floor, 2021
  - Not to reflect on vote of another member, 1352
  - Not to stand up or move about until Speaker leaves Chair as it makes it difficult to see members who may wish to speak, 1811
  - Personal remarks, 291, 2366
  - Provincial government policies, 287-9
  - Provocative remarks, 786
  - Questioned after conclusion of speech needs unanimous consent to reply, 195, 3182
  - Questioned after resuming seat, no longer has right to speak, 802
  - Referring to another member by name, 1313, 1397
  - Setting up two-way communication system which bypasses Chair, 292
  - Shall be seated when Chair rises, 1863, 2402
  - Should address remarks through Chair, 2071, 2275
  - To end remarks when Chair rises, 2421
  - To speak one at a time, 2167

  - Question on, 702
  - Unanimous consent to make on orders of the day, 17
- Motion for papers, agreed to, returning to order paper and standing over, unanimous consent, 1135-6
