Inquiries of the Ministry

perhaps not the Minister of Finance who should concern himself in the first instance with regional disparities, but we have a Minister of Regional Economic Expansion whose proper concern it is and who effectively signed with the province of Prince Edward Island a month or so ago a FRED plan under which the federal government will be contributing \$125 million.

Mr. Donald MacInnis (Cape Breton-East Richmond): A supplementary question, Mr. Speaker. In order to keep abreast of the affairs going on in the government, I ask the Prime Minister, who is the Minister of Forestry and Rural Development?

Mr. Trudeau: There is none, Mr. Speaker.

Mr. MacInnis: A further supplementary question, Mr. Speaker. Would the Prime Minister take care to be accurate in the future?

Some hon. Members: Oh, oh.

Hon. J. A. MacLean (Malpeque): A supplementary question, Mr. Speaker, to the Minister of Regional Economic Expansion. I ask the minister whether he intends to hold conversations in the near future with the government of Prince Edward Island relative to financial problems which are outside of the comprehensive development plan.

RUBELLA EPIDEMIC—ACCESSIBILITY TO VACCINE

Mr. P. B. Rynard (Simcoe North): Mr. Speaker, I have a question for the Minister of National Health and Welfare, one of urgent concern to all Canadian women who may become mothers during the next few years.

In view of the medical expectation of an epidemic of rubella during 1970 and 1971, and in view of the possible resultant causation of fetal abnormalities more widespread than those during the thalidomide tragedy, can the minister inform the house what the prospects are for Canadian women to have access to supplies of the Cendehill anti-rubella vaccine, which newspapers say has recently been licensed in Switzerland?
