BILL.

An Act to amend the Act respecting Public Officers.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide that any public Preamble. officer of Canada required to furnish security for the due performance of the trust reposed in him and for other purposes, may, instead of furnishing security in the manner 5 provided by the "Act respecting Public Officers," conditionally R.S.C., c. 19. assign to the Crown any deposit standing in his name in the books of the Post Office or any other Government Savings Bank as such security : Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of 10 Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :--

1. Section twenty-two of chapter nineteen of the Revised Section 22 of Statutes of Canada is hereby repealed and the following repealed. substituted therefor :

"22. - payable to the depositor in like manner as if no such assignment had been made."
