The question of compulsory inspection of gain was introduced and discussed at length by Messrs. McCreary, A. A. McArthur, Galt, Jones and others; and on the motion of Mr. A. A McArthur, seconded by Mr. F W. Stobart, the following resolution was carried unanimously :-

Resolved, That this Board desires to urge epon the Dominion Government the necessity for a compulsory inspection of grain, with itscentre in Winnipeg, and that all wheat be in geeted and graded before leaving this Province for an eastern market.

The New Railway Gong.

The bell cord suspended from ring guides, with has so long been used to sound degong on our railroad trains, is now being aplaced by an arrangement consisting of a set d tubes fastened beneath the cars and joined egether upon the same principle as the air thes. These are in communication with a restoir containing air to the pressure of 15 goands per square inch above the atmosphere, Wich is furnished by the Westinghouse airtake. A rope in each car leads to a valve. tich discharges the excess of air contained in time tubes; and the reduction of air pressure athe resevoir at the engine causes the whistle b sound. If the train breaks the whistle ands continuously, but when the rope is iched it sounds only as the nir escapes.—Chi-23 Journal of Commerce.
