mies, what will be the next Object of the French Ambition?

However useless some may think it, to enquire into the Causes of unsuccessful Events, or to shew how the Misfortunes we have suffered might once have been avoided: there is certainly no Way so effectual to make us attentive to our future Conduct, as to consider the Losses we have sustained, and the Sources from whence they fprung: And it is undoubtedly the Wish of every good Subject, That the Sense of our past Sufferings and Disgrace may animate our Commanders with that noble Indignation, and excite in them those Sentiments of Glory, which must be for ever followed by Victory and Success.
