AN IMPORTANT QUESTION. Can the Agreement With the Canadian Niagara Power Company Be Voided? An important stated case was argued yesterday at Osprey Hall before Sir William Meredith, C. J., Mr. Justice Rose and Mr. Justice McLaughlin. The question to be decided is whether or not the agreement of the Canadian Niagara Power Company should be voided because of the failure of the company to have "completed" water connections for the development of 25,000 horse-power and have actually ready for supply and transmission, 10,000 de-horse-power by Nov. 1, 1898. The developed horse-power they have not been able to complete the works because of the experimental character of electrical development and the magnitude and description of the works in question, to be used for long-distance transmission. The real-estate paid by the company to the commission to Nov. 1, 1898, is \$150,000. The case was submitted to the Government for the opinion of the Divisional Court, and the questions which the court is asked to answer are:
